## Student cell phone and electronics policy

- 3. Access your account by entering the email address we have on file for you at the school. If you need to update your email, please call our office staff at 250-832-6031 and they can enter your email into the system.
- 4. If you have more than one child, you will have to request a password for <u>each child.</u> Once you have done this, you can change the passwords so that they are the same and all of your children's names come up under one email.

#### **School Fees**

#### **Traffic Flow**

Shuswap Middle is a very busy place during drop off and pick up times – Please be super cautious and expect the unexpected! Students must be dropped off and picked up in the lower parking lot or Little Mountain Sports Complex parking lot across the street (There is a crossing guard there in the mornings and afternoons). The upper parking lot is closed to the public during peak drop off and pick up times.
